## **Adult Winter Reading Program**

The Boone County Library adult winter reading program is in full swing and welcomes newcomers to join in on the fun. Participants must be age 18 or older with a current Boone County Library card that is in good standing (no outstanding balances).

The theme for this year's program is "Trek Across the Universe Through Books." The library has many nonfiction books about the universe available for check-out in the 520's of the Dewey Decimal System, including some that are oversized. There is also a collection of novels that have an outer space theme. A list of suggested reading for this program is included.

Monthly drawings will be held as a reward for reading. Readers will be given the 'captain's log' to record books read. Those participating can have staff members at the circulation desk initial and date the log and give participants an entry form for a prize drawing.
