A Little History by Ginger Milan

The Boone County Library owes its beginnings to the Women's Book Club of Harrison. Nine women met in June of 1900 to organize the library. The women purchased land, had a building constructed and moved in 1903. A total of 600 books were donated by the women and members of the community to start the library. That first building currently houses The Gallery, owned and operated by local artist, Gene Brantley. When the library outgrew its first home, it moved into a building adjacent to North Arkansas Regional Medical Center. This was home to the library from 1968 until 1986 when it was moved to its current location one block west of the Courthouse Square.
