I wish to discuss a couple of topics: Friends Executive Committee and membership and recognition.

Perhaps you have already noticed if you peruse this page 2 regularly, the changes in titles and shifts in responsibilities. Most members are the same as last year at this time, with these few changes:

- Roberta Beatty has resigned as Vice President (VP) HomeBound Delivery, replaced temporarily by George Cline. We thank Roberta for her several years service excellence, maintaining and expanding the program.
- Chris Posterick has been relieved of VP Day Care Reading but remains VP – Newsletter Editor, mailer and supervisor of the FOL Honor Book Program.
- Louise Mahaffey replaced Chris as VP Day Care Reading. Louise, with help from George Cline, is implementing the placement of minilibraries at certain day schools. Fifty books is usual number in these libraries and they are exchanged with new books once per month. This is a pilot project yet to be adopted as a formal program. The data, so far, support adoption.

Now to discuss and perhaps even clarify memberships and recognition. The usual membership categories are denoted on the Financial Supporters page of this newsletter.
