Just a few statistics on our services:

- We have 500-700 hundred people a day come to the library.
- Our public computers are used over 4,000 times a month.
- Close to 300 children participated in our Summer Reading Program.
- We have people from literally all over the world contact our Genealogy Department for assistance.
- Outreach to all of Boone County is becoming more robust daily.

Improvement that is being addressed now:

 The original 48 year old roof, with patches and skylights, are contracted to be replaced at this time – more details elsewhere in this newsletter.

Some of the items that will need to be addressed soon are:

- The heating and cooling system, original to the building, is 48 years old.
- Some of the windows need to be replaced.
- The lighting needs to be updated to conserve energy.
- The carpet was installed in 1985 and needs to be replaced.
