My thanks to Ginger Schoenenberger, Library Director, and her staff for their kind and gracious support. They're never too busy to stop and help.



## **NorthArk needs GED Tutors**

A new program with NorthArk has great potential to help people in our community by tutoring low-literacy students prepare for the GED test. We're asking retired or active teachers to volunteer for 1-2 hours sessions weekly. At the tutor's convenience, the tutor will meet with the student for 1-2 hours weekly at the college. NorthArk hours are Monday – Thursday between 8AM-5PM.

NorthArk's Assistant Director of Education, Amy Roberts, will arrange the meetings between tutor and student and provide work space, materials and lesson plans.
